 We are delighted to inform you that Mrs Small is expecting her second child. This means that she will continue to teach P3/4 on 3 days of the week until the October half term break when she will start her Maternity Leave. After this Miss Marshall will teach P3/4 full time until June 2023.

SCHOOL DAY

It is our aim to provide a safe, family friendly environment. We welcome children who are not attending breakfast club, to arrive at school from **8:50am** each day when they will be supervised by class teachers. Our school day begins at **9am SHARP**, please ensure that your child arrives on time each day. If a child arrives late they will be marked on the roll as late. If the child is persistently late, the Education Welfare Officer will become involved.

If your child is absent from school, you must provide a written note to your child's teacher explaining the reason for the absence on their return to school.

If for any reason you need to collect your child from school earlier than their normal finishing time, you must put it in writing to your child's teacher. You must also ensure that you complete the signing out book in the entrance area, this is a necessary part of our Safeguarding procedure.

If your child is being collected from school by someone other than the named adults listed on your form, please put it in writing to your child's class teacher.

BREAKFAST CLUB

We hope to commence Breakfast Club week beginning 5th September. In light of the current economic crisis we are all facing, we have been considering ways in which we can help and support families. One of the ways in which we are planning to do this is by running breakfast club 5 days per week. The club will run Monday – Friday each week. (We may have to review this in December depending on our funding situation.) The school is open from 7:50am and children who wish to have breakfast need to be in school by 8:10am. Breakfast consists of cereal, toast, fruit juice & tea. As well as providing children with a healthy breakfast, this club also offers a variety of informal learning activities. Children help to tidy up and go to class at 8:45am. This service will continue to be free of charge to all pupils. It is funded through our Extended Schools Programme. It is hoped that this small gesture will help families.

I would also remind families that we as a school provide children with ALL stationery items, there is no need for families to purchase these.

BREAK

The school operates a healthy break policy and children are asked not to bring fizzy drinks, sweets, chocolate or crisps. They can purchase a variety of items from the school kitchen:

Lunchtime is from **12:15 – 1:05pm**. School meals cost £2.60 per day / £13 per week. We would ask that dinner slips / payments be returned to your child's class teacher on a Monday, indicating your child's choice of meal for each day.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

If you think your child / children are entitled to free school meals can you please ensure that you apply **BEFORE** the start of term. You must do this online by logging on to eani.org.uk. If you are having difficulty with this, please contact Mrs Marshall in the school office – 02820741585.

TRANSFER

We would respectfully remind parents that entrance into these public examinations is a parental responsibility. AQE forms can be downloaded from www.aqe.org.uk and are also available from the school office should you have any difficulty. Please note the last date for application is **FRIDAY 23rd SEPTEMBER 2022**. If you wish to discuss any related queries you are most welcome to contact Mrs Alcorn or myself.

In order to ensure the most effective use of resources we prefer that parents receive newsletters and notes by email. Please ensure that the school office has your most up to date email address. Please inform Mrs Marshall in the school office if you do not have email access and we can arrange for a hard copy of any newsletter/ note to be sent to you. Please ensure that you have also downloaded our School Jotter App – we put a lot of important information out through our App so it is vitally important that all parents have access to this.

EXTRA CURRICULAR

We have been working with a range of outside agencies and coaches to enable us to provide the children with a wide variety of after school activities. We are in the process of finalising details of our Term 1 activities and will issue a timetable of activities in due course.

COMMUNICATION

We actively encourage open lines of communication through our Class Dojo system, please ensure that you are signed up to this for your child's class.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that any issue relating to the classroom should be brought, first and foremost, to the attention of the class teacher – this can be done very effectively through the Class Dojo, or if you prefer you can telephone the school office and arrange a suitable time to speak with the teacher.

Administration matters, for example, absence, forgotten PE kits / lunchboxes, changes to pick up arrangements etc can be telephoned in to Mrs Marshall in the school office who will pass the information on to the relevant teacher.
